HOW FAR CAN YOUR DONATIONS GO?

Kids Club Kampala is a Christian organisation which aims to bring hope and show God's love to vulnerable children in Uganda. The children we work with come from impoverished communities in Uganda where even small donations can go a long way and make a huge difference. Even basic needs such as food, school supplies, blankets and mosquito nets are out of reach for many families in these areas. With your help we can make the lives of these kids better and provide them with basic things that you and I may take for granted here at home.

Here's an idea of how far some of your donations for Kids Club Kampala can go..

General costs

To run Kids Club Kampala weekly at all 11 centres costs just **£18** a week. This includes transport costs for volunteers and sweets/ biscuits for all the children. This works out at **£75** a month, or **£900** a year.

Play equipment

To provide enough play materials for one centre (approximately 400 kids) for one month costs **£30**.

This includes footballs, bubbles, small balls, skipping ropes and parachutes. To equip all 11 centres with enough play materials for one month costs **£330**.



First Aid

To supply one centre with first aid materials for a month costs **£50**. For all centres to have a fully stocked first aid kit including plasters, iodine, antiseptic, cotton wool, bandages, gloves, etc costs **£550**.

Food

To provide food for one centre for one day costs **£90** for a meal of rice and cabbage and a drink of juice.

Many of the kids who attend Kids Club Kampala are undernourished and often go hungry, so providing a hot meal for these children means so much.

For a more nutritious meal which includes it will cost **£115**.

To feed all children at all centres one meal will cost **£1000**.



School Supplies

To provide school supplies for one centre will cost **£200** for one school term. This means each child will receive 6 exercise books, a pencil and a pen.



Crafts Project

To run the crafts project for one month at one centre costs **£30**. This price includes costs of materials to make the crafts, and transport costs for the instructors.

To run a crafts project at each centre every month will cost **£300**.

The crafts initiative teaches unemployed women and older girls how to make jewellery and other crafts. This provides them with vocational skills. The crafts are then sold to raise money to fund Kids Club Kampala activities.



Clothes

A clothes giveaway for one Kids Club Kampala centre costs **£150** for a bundle of clothes. This means each child receives at least one item of clothing.

To supply all children at all centres with clothes, the total cost will be **£1500**.



Shoes

To provide a pair of basic shoes for all kids at one centre will cost **£175**. For all children at all centres to receive shoes, this will cost **£1750**.



Soap

For all children at one KCK centre to receive a large bar of soap will cost **£105**. To give a bar of soap to all children at all centres will cost around **£1150**.

Mosquito Nets

To buy a mosquito net for one child costs only **£3**. To provide mosquito nets for all children at one centre costs **£860**. For all children at all Kids Club Kampala centres to receive a mosquito net, it will cost around **£9000**.

Christmas Party

A Christmas party for all children at all centres to come together for a day of fun, games, food and friendship costs **£450**.



Thank you for taking an interest in KCK. As you can see a relatively small amount goes a long way and can make a big impact on the communities we work with. Small donations can help to provide basic essentials for Kids Club Kampala. These are just a few examples of some of our expenses, there are many more extra general running costs which haven't been included in this book.
